In 2024, the EPICENTER served over 13,000 neighbors in need, creating opportunities for connection, growth, and hope across our communities. This year wasn't just about meeting needs—it was about transforming lives.

YOUTH

In 2024, The EPICENTER's youth programs made a powerful impact, serving **131** unique kids in Before/After School programs across Aberdeen and Edgewood, with ABR welcoming Pre-K students for the first time. **158** kids enjoyed Camp EPIC, filled with enriching activities and field trips, while events like two Macy's Shopping Sprees serving **79** kids and the Holiday Shops (**450** kids) brought joy and support to families. Through these programs, we're building brighter futures and stronger communities!

TABITHA'S HOUSE

Tabitha's House achieved tremendous growth and success, solidifying its role as a cornerstone of community support. Our thrift stores provided 6,672 items of clothing, valued at \$89,171, to neighbors in need for FREE, while the Edgewood store surpassed expectations with a 66% increase in sales and outgrowing its space. The inaugural Purses with Purpose event raised over \$50,000, inspiring donors and guests with its impact. With total revenue reaching an 18% increase from last year, Tabitha's House continues to make a lasting difference and is poised for even greater expansion ahead!







RECOVERY

The EPICENTER's recovery programs supported **2,416** individuals last year through AA, NA, and Celebrate Recovery, offering hope, community, and a path to healing. Each story of resilience highlights the power of connection and the impact of walking alongside those in recovery. Together, we're building brighter futures!

HEALTH & WELLNESS

Our food pantries and giveaways resulted in more than 107,000 pounds of food being distributed to neighbors facing food insecurity. During our Project Connect event, 61 nonprofits provided resources to over 450 community members, resulting in 57 free haircuts, 22 expunged records, 104 eye exams, and 128 connected to housing resources.





LIFE SKILLS

1,091 neighbors received support through our case management services. Countless more visited us during Community Cafe hours to use free wifi, enjoy hot coffee, and have a quiet space to work or rest.

PARKVILLE

We are thrilled to announce that the EPICENTER at Parkville is on track to open in April 2026! This incredible milestone reflects years of prayer, planning, and partnership. We now own the building and have completed all permitting and design work in collaboration with our civil engineer and architects. As we prepare to break ground, demolition and construction are set to begin in the spring of 2025.

Our number one goal with this new location is to reach more people, extend hope to the hopeless, and make a lasting impact in the Parkville community. While the building is under construction, we'll launch outreach efforts in the spring of 2025 to connect with our neighbors, build relationships, and establish trust. We couldn't be more ready to see lives transformed through this expansion!
